Movement of Heavy Vehicles and all Goods Carriage Vehicles **over the PVNR Express way** was prohibited vide reference 1st cited above in view of road safety and traffic management. Vide reference 2nd cited above, the Rajendranagar Traffic Police have informed that there is an urgent need to revise the earlier notification to include two-wheelers, 3-wheelers, Medium Motor vehicles, Tractors & other Agriculture-related vehicles, pedestrians in view of road safety and traffic management.


Hence, in exercise of the powers conferred upon me under Section 7 Clause (1) of Cyberabad City Police Act R/W Section 21 Clause (1) (b) of Hyderabad City Police Act 1348-F, I, V.C. Sajjanar, IPS., Commissioner of Police, Cyberabad do hereby notify the following the below regulatory orders in supersession of the earlier order vide reference 1st cited above for the information of general public:

1. There will be a complete prohibition on the movement of two-wheelers, 3-wheelers, Tractors and other agriculture-related vehicles, push carts, Heavy vehicles, Medium Motor Vehicles & all Goods Carriage Vehicles and the pedestrians over the PVNR Express way in Cyberabad Commissionerate jurisdiction.

2. All such above mentioned vehicles i.e., Medium Motor Vehicles, Heavy vehicles and All Goods carriage vehicles requiring to move over the PVNR Express way will have to seek permission from the office of DCP (Traffic), Cyberabad. Permission will be given only on case to case basis depending on emergency.

Such permitted vehicle should display the permission and the drivers should carry it with them at all times.

The above restrictions will come into force with immediate effect and those found violating the above restrictions will be prosecuted as per law.
